Challenge Stadium -30 November

Please note that the Danny Green fight is taking place at Challenge Stadium on 30 November and access the venue for non-boxing patrons will be through the rear access off McGillvray Road which leads into the UWA sports park at the rear of Challenge Stadium.

Parking will be out the back either in Challenge car parks or across the road in UWA car parks and will be limited. VenuesWest has suggested carpooling.

Entry will be through the rear entrance to the building and all patrons should enter through the 10-lane pool gate. Entry will be as normal with reception staff placed at the 10-lane entry instead of upstairs at the main entrance.

Trinity College Pool

As tenants at Trinity College Pool we have certain obligations that have to be maintained. On occasions these have not been met and for the greater good of the Club a reminder is set out below as to what needs to be done after training sessions:

1. Lights to be turned off;
2. Goals to be lifted out and placed gently on the pool deck and not dragged;
3. Pool entry gate to be closed at the conclusion of each training session;
4. Lane ropes to be replaced after each training session unless advised otherwise for school water polo training the next morning;
5. Pool office to be left locked;
6. Any food/drink to be put in the poolside bin;
7. Pool cleaner to be placed in the pool after training;
8. Pool cages to be left locked.

With a little bit of effort on everyone's behalf these requirements can be met to keep our Landlord happy.
